WHO WE ARE AND WHAT WE DO

The **Aj Ty v IT** civic association was founded in 2012 with the aim of providing motivation and support for girls and women in the field of Information Technology. The aim of the association, expressed by the motto "Technology has no gender", is to build a technologically equal society and to ensure that women are not left on the sidelines, but become a direct part of the future of technology. Through its activities, Aj Ty v IT is breaking down social stereotypes about women in IT, devoting itself to building community, and educating girls from the age of 8 all the way to secondary school and special educational programmes designed for adult women and teachers. We also cooperate with IT faculties at various universities. During its existence, tens of thousands of girls, women and teachers from all over Slovakia have completed the workshops, courses and academies hosted by the association.

The main benefit of our activities for girls and women is gaining access to quality education, with subsequent possibilities for employment with greater value on the labour market.

We introduce different technologies to **young girls** in a creative and fun way. Our goal is to awaken and encourage a natural interest in IT, and show that they can embrace the world of technology. At the same time, we want to prevent stereotypes they might encounter in their social circles.

When it comes to **secondary school students**, we foster their interest in studying IT and help them acquire a set of basic and advanced digital skills to make it easier for them to enter the job market, regardless of whether they go on to pursue higher education.

We offer **adult women** opportunities for further growth and development, or a career change, either within their previous field (upskilling), or a brand new one (reskilling).

In recent years, we have also focused on **educational activities for teachers** because we want to help them better work with girls and create more interesting content in their classrooms.



WHY DO WE DO IT?

Our target group is **GIRLS AND WOMEN**.

For Them and With Them:

- building community
- we educate and support them in exploring technology
- we break stereotypes and inspire

We often hear about the lack of IT professionals. The lack of women in the IT sector is a whole other chapter. We have decided to change that.

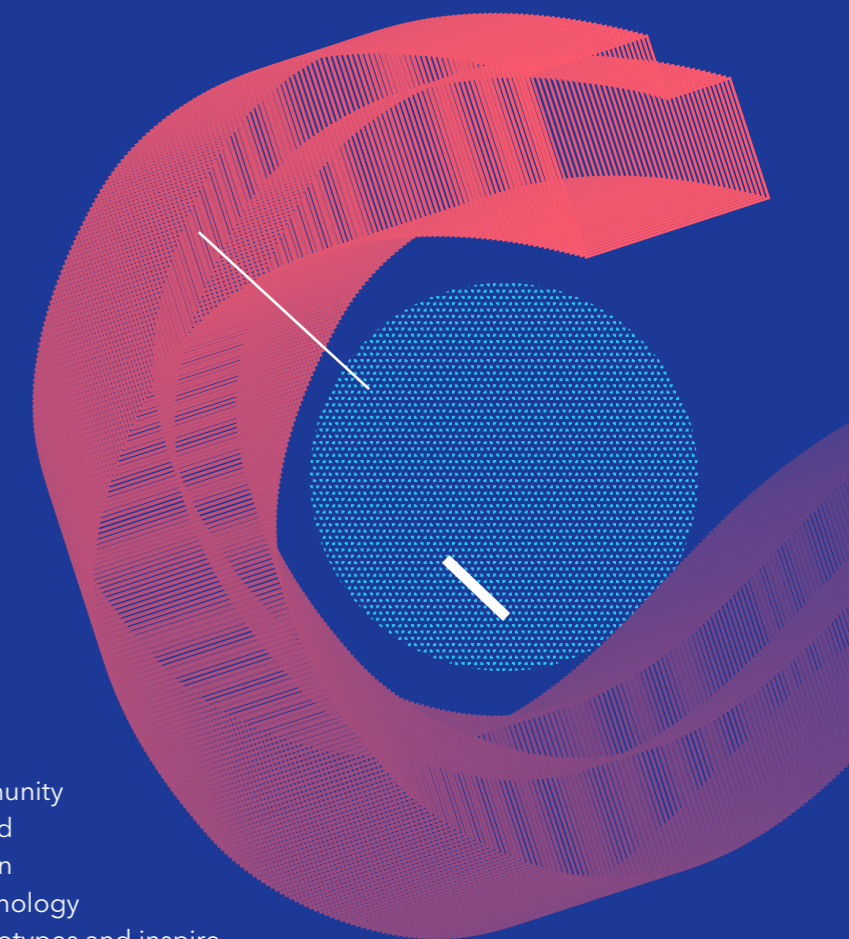
We started in 2012, back at a time when **young women in IT faculties** made up only **3 to 5%** of the total number of students. Although this figure has risen to **15%** in the ten years of our existence, we still have a long way ahead of us to reach the European average.

Technology affects our entire life these days. However, technological development is to a large extent driven only by men primarily concerned by their needs and life experiences. It is important that the technologies that help us in everyday life are created by **diverse teams**. That will ensure the products they develop will consider the needs and experiences of a wide range of users - both men and women.

Empowering women in the IT sector is therefore necessary and useful, not only for women who would like to find themselves in the field, but also for all end-users in general.

Surveys shows that the creation of all-girl groups has a positive impact on the growth of their motivation. The reason for the lack of interest in computer science classes is the fact girls often have a hard time asserting themselves in mixed classes with a significant dominance by boys.

Aj Ty v IT activities are bringing about a new dimension to IT education for girls and women.

HOW WE WORK

The deeper we dig into this subject, the more issues we uncover. That is why we have gradually progressed through working with secondary school girls to educating adult women, and young girls from the age of 8.

What does it look like in real life?

PRIMARY SCHOOLS

We organize activities for primary school students:

- MICRO:BIT** Basics of programming with a minicomputer
- OZOBOTS** Basics of logic with pen and paper
- LEGO ROBOTS** Clear and playful path to programming
- SCRATCH** Visual programming language ideal for first coding

SECONDARY SCHOOLS

We organize events for secondary school students:

- GIRL'S DAY** Career Day, during which secondary school girls can get a glimpse into IT companies and organizations across Slovakia.
- SPOZNAJ IT faCOOLty (MEET IT faCOOLties)** The best way to overcome fears of studying at a STEM school is to visit one and, with the help of a mentor, gain the opportunity to ask about everything of interest to secondary school students.
- SECURITY GIRL** We offer cybersecurity education to secondary school girls, enabling them to properly protect themselves and their data, but also act as security liaisons in their school and community.
- Aj Ty v IT CODING CLUBS** Every month a new topic and new IT skills.

ADULT WOMEN

For adult women, we offer one-time workshops and short and long term courses:

WORKSHOPS AND SHORT-TERM COURSES We are helping participants to decide which area in IT to pursue in their future via one-time workshops and short-term courses focused on different IT topics. These topics include internet security, SQL, project management, etc.

WOMEN ACADEMIES The aim of our academies is to prepare participants for specific junior IT positions or to help them gain IT skills to use in their current job. The intensive courses include both theoretical and practical components to help the participant find their way in the field, learn the relevant processes, gain practical skills and, for selected academies, even certification.

TEACHERS

Through specialized IT training, we give teaching staff many opportunities to grow. Our presence at schools helps them in their teaching practice. Thanks to the TECHLIB project, we make hardware available to them, whether for their own training or for the benefit of teaching children in their classrooms.

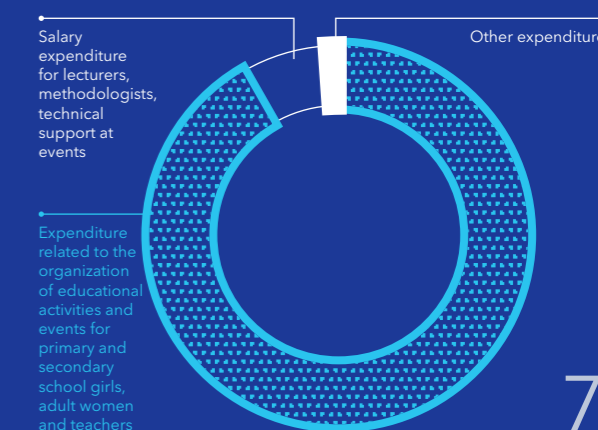
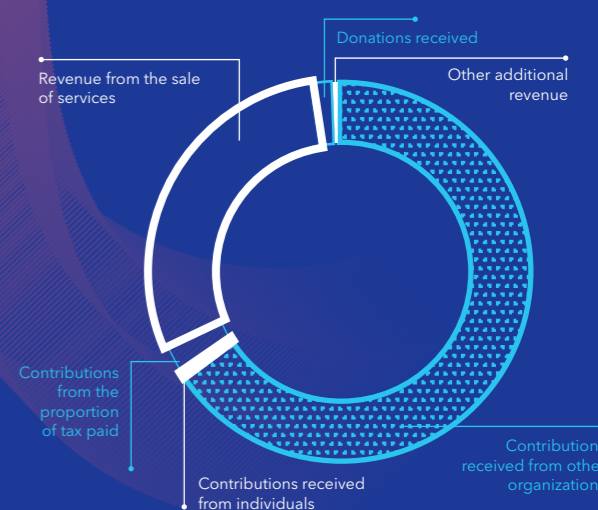
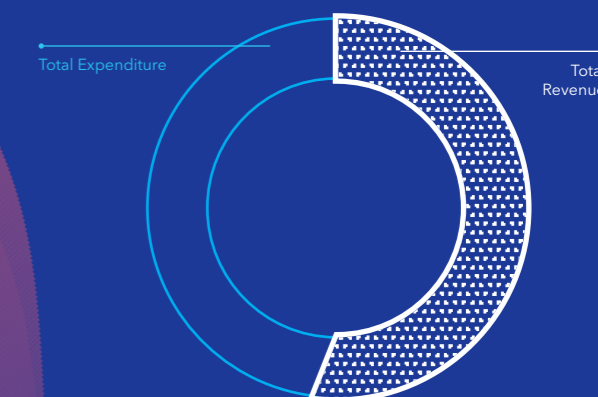
